What is AB 341?

The governor and the state legislature have made it a priority to increase recycling, thereby reducing landfills. By doing so, they hope to reduce the toxic greenhouse gases that are a natural product of the normal process of waste decomposition over time.

AB 341 is a state law that requires all businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of waste weekly to recycle. To comply with AB 341, make sure your business has arranged for recycling services. Separate recyclable items from trash at the source, inside your business facility.

Place your recyclable items in external recycling containers for collection.

What can be recycled? Here is a list:

Clean, dry paper including newspaper, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, used office paper, manila folders, phone books, all plastics, bubble wrap, shrink wrap, paper bags & shredded paper in clear plastic bags.

Cardboard and Chipboard.
All beverage containers.
All plastics, including jugs and storage bins.

Metal and aluminum containers and empty aerosol cans. Metal hand tools, including hammers, jigsaws, screwdrivers, staplers and wrenches.

Small appliances with a cord, like toasters, coffee makers, microwave and toaster ovens.

Unpainted and untreated wood like block shelves and wood pallets.
